Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Corrections for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018

Discussion

The Department of Corrections contracts with the Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to provide community based tuberculosis skin testing to its employees, volunteers and interns. If tests are positive, PHHS provides education to the employee on the risks, consequences and treatment of tuberculosis infections.
