Re: Setting a Public Hearing for Third Avenue Alley Restoration Project

## Executive Summary

Setting a public hearing for April 1, 2019 for the construction of the Third Avenue Alley Restoration Project from Grand Avenue to Garth Avenue. This project includes construction of a 10-foot wide asphalt lane in the alley located from Grand Avenue to Garth Avenue between Third Avenue and Forest Avenue. An Interested Parties (IP) meeting was held on February 21, 2019.

## Discussion

The Third Avenue Alley Restoration Project will include paving a 10-foot wide lane in the alley located from Grand Avenue to Garth Avenue between Third Avenue and Forest Avenue (see attached location map). The alley restoration project includes approximately 583 linear feet of asphalt pavement with a concrete entrance at Grand Avenue and at Garth Avenue. In order to address storm water runoff, a side opening inlet will be constructed and connected to an existing 5' X 5' area inlet. Temporary construction easements may be necessary for construction of the project. A copy of the concept design is also attached.

An IP meeting was held on February 21, 2019. Eight residents attended the meeting. No comments were submitted.

Construction is planned for the fall of 2019. The estimated total project cost (includes design, easements, and construction) for the proposed Alley project is \$150,000. The project will be funded by Transportation Sales Tax.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The estimated total project cost is \$150,000 and will be funded by Transportation Sales Tax.

Long-Term Impact: Routine cost for maintenance for the improvement is estimated as \$325 per year.
