Re: Authorizing a Bid Call for Reconstruction of Taxiway C at the Columbia Regional Airport

Executive Summary

Authorizing a bid call through the Purchasing division for reconstruction of approximately 2,800' x 35' of Taxiway C at the Columbia Regional Airport. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$2,832,630, which is eligible for 90% reimbursement by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). A public hearing is scheduled for April 17, 2017. Staff anticipates that the project will be constructed in FY2018.

Discussion

On February 6, 2017, Council authorized a professional engineering services agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company for design services related to the reconstruction of approximately 2,800' x 35' of Taxiway C at the Columbia Regional Airport. The improvement project will abut Runway 13-31, which is currently under construction to lengthen and widen the runway to 5,500' x 100'. The construction of these two projects will achieve a runway to taxiway centerline separation of 400' as required by the FAA.

The estimated construction cost for this project is \$2,832,630, which is eligible for 90% reimbursement by the FAA. The City's 10% local match will be funded by Transportation Sales Tax. The project is expected to be constructed in FY2018.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The estimated cost for reconstruction of Taxiway C is \$2,832,630. The FAA will reimburse the City 90% of this amount, or \$2,549,367.00. The City's 10% local match of \$283,263.00 will be paid from Transportation Sales Tax funds.
