#### **Executive Summary**

This resolution would grant permission for the City Manager to work with the University of Missouri Athletics Department, the Central Business District and other business entities to provide and garner community support of the upcoming Mizzou football season.

#### Discussion

As the Mizzou Football season begins it is important for the city to reinvigorate community spirit and support for Mizzou Athletics and grow community engagement to enhance the game day experience for our students and visitors to Columbia.

Working with Mizzou Athletics and the Downtown CID we want to look at ways to make this happen. Examples could include erecting Mizzou flags on downtown flag or light poles, placing or painting M-I-Z-Z-O-U logos at major intersections and/or along Broadway and 8<sup>th</sup> Street and working with MoDOT to repaint Tiger Paws on exit ramps leading into Columbia.

Specific details, planning and review of budgets would need to be decided and coordinated working with the Mizzou Athletics, The District and other city departments.
