A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of sidewalk on the west side of Fifth Street between Elm Street and Stewart Road to facilitate masonry restoration and repairs on the Gas Turbine Building located at 417 S. Fifth Street.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the University of Missouri to close a portion of sidewalk on the west side of Fifth Street between Elm Street and Stewart Road, as shown on "Exhibit A," from August 3, 2020 to September 30, 2020 to facilitate masonry restoration and repairs on the Gas Turbine Building located at 417 S. Fifth Street.

SECTION 2. The University of Missouri shall close the portion of sidewalk only in accordance with the closure plan submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying the University of Missouri, in writing, of such requirements. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the sidewalk due to any damage caused by the construction activity. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. The University of Missouri shall proceed with construction activities which require the sidewalk closure without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the closure permit by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The temporary sidewalk closure authorized herein may be terminated by the City Council upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and a determination such closure is no longer necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public or is otherwise in the best interest of the public.
