A RESOLUTION

transferring ownership of a 2005 Barrett Horse Trailer used by the Columbia Police Department (City Vehicle #1151) to the Cedar Creek Therapeutic Riding Center.

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2006, the City Council adopted Resolution R126-06 which accepted donation of a 2005 Barrett Horse Trailer from the Columbia Police Foundation that was donated by Mike Teel of Mid-City Lumber Company and was used by the Police Department's mounted patrol unit; and

WHEREAS, due to budget constraints, the Police Department disbanded the mounted patrol unit in 2015; and

WHEREAS, Cedar Creek Therapeutic Riding Center, a local non-profit organization that provides horseback riding therapy to more than 200 people with disabilities each year, is in need of a replacement horse trailer; and

WHEREAS, Mike Teel has expressed his support to transfer ownership of the donated horse trailer from the Columbia Police Department to the Cedar Creek Therapeutic Riding Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the transfer of ownership of a 2005 Barrett Horse Trailer that was used by the Columbia Police Department (City Vehicle #1151) to the Cedar Creek Therapeutic Riding Center.
