AN ORDINANCE

repealing Section 3 of Ordinance No. 024211 to lift the temporary waiver relating to the issuance and payment of parking meter hoods; providing an emergency clause for enactment on the day of introduction of the bill; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 024211 on April 6, 2020 to provide, in part, for a temporary waiver in the collection of payment when parking meter hoods were issued to any restaurant located adjacent to metered parking spaces for curbside or carryout services to customers; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health and Human Services issued Order No. 2020-06, Reopening Plan – Phase 2, Step 2, with an effective date of May 26, 2020; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the reopening plan issued by the Director, the City Council desires to repeal Section 3 of Ordinance No. 024211 to lift the temporary waiver relating to the issuance and payment of parking meter hoods; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it is necessary to preserve the public health, safety and welfare to enact such repeal as an emergency ordinance on the day of introduction so that it may go into effect immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Repeal of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 024211. The City Council hereby repeals Section 3 of Ordinance No. 024211 passed on April 6, 2020, to lift the temporary waiver relating to the issuance and payment of parking meter hoods. The remaining sections of Ordinance No. 024211 relating to other emergency enactment provisions and the payment of transportation fares will continue to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. Emergency clause, effective date and duration. This ordinance is enacted as an emergency ordinance within the meaning of Article II of Section 15 of the Home Rule Charter of the City. This ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage by six-sevenths (6/7) of the members of the City Council.
