## **Executive Summary**

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the COVID-19 and Adult Vaccination Supplemental program services contract between the City of Columbia and Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$197,913 for the period of February 1, 2021 through January 31, 2024.

#### Discussion

This agreement provides funding from Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services to support local efforts to plan, develop and maintain a public health workforce to increase COVID-19 and adult vaccination capacity across jurisdictions, including among high-risk and underserved populations; ensure high-quality and safe administration of vaccines; ensure equitable distribution and administration of vaccines; increase vaccine confidence through education, outreach and partnerships; develop and implement community engagement strategies to promote vaccination efforts and utilize immunization information systems to support efficient vaccination efforts.
