**AN ORDINANCE**

accepting conveyances for drainage and sewer purposes;  
accepting Stormwater Management/BMP Facilities Covenants;  
directing the City Clerk to have the conveyances and  
Stormwater Management/BMP Facilities Covenants recorded;  
and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS  
FOLLOWS:
