Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services WIC Local Agency Nutrition Services Program Services Contract

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the program services contract for WIC Local Agency Nutrition Services, between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract period is October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

Discussion

This contract allows the Department of Public Health and Human Services to provide supplementary nutrition packages and nutrition education to low income pregnant and breastfeeding women, infants, and children through age 5 years.

Total funding is based on caseload number, which is determined by the average number of participants served in the previous year. DHSS has determined the contract will be based on a participant count of 27,891 for FY2019 which is based on the average number of participants from FY2018. The total grant for FY2018 is \$390,474 for FY2019. FY 2019, the department will be reimbursed at a rate of \$14.00 per participant.
