Executive Summary

An amendment sheet has been prepared to add financial responsibilities language within the cost share agreement.

Discussion

On May 5, 2025, an ordinance was introduced and had its first read for a cost share agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) for additional pedestrian improvements with the Improve I-70: Columbia to Kingdom City project.

After that Council Meeting was held, MHTC made a change to the agreement in Section 9(A) Financial Responsibilities. The sentences "Cost Share funds shall not be used off the State Highway System. The pedestrian improvements listed in Exhibit A of this Agreement are deemed eligible for Cost Share funds, as agreed by the Commission and the City." were added.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The City's match of \$1,016,250 will be funded by transportation sales tax funds.
