Re: Issuance of Liquor License to a Business Located Within 100 Feet of School and Church

Executive Summary

An application has been made to the City's Business License Division for the issuance of a liquor license to sell beer/wine to an establishment called 260 Bar LLC, d/b/a Brookside Poolside located at 260 South Tenth Street. This location is within 100 feet of University of Missouri Property and a church. Section 311.080 of the State Statute requires written permission of the City Council prior to the issuance of such license. The attached Resolution will authorize the issuance of a liquor license to this business.

Discussion

Section 311.080 of the State Statute establishes that no license shall be granted for the sale of intoxicating liquor within 100 feet of any school, church or other building regularly used as a place of religious worship, unless the license applicant shall first obtain the written consent of the City Council. It also states such consent shall not be granted until at least 10 days written notice has been provided to all property owners within 100 feet of the proposed licensed premises. Such notification has been provided.
