

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on William Street between Paris Road and Walnut Street, and on Hinkson Avenue between Paris Road and Old 63 North; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on William Street between Paris Road and Walnut Street, and on Hinkson Avenue between Paris Road and Old 63 North, was held by the Public Works Department on October 15, 2019, September 2, 2020, and virtually from March 1, 2021 to March 12, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on May 3, 2021. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on William Street between Paris Road and Walnut Street, and on Hinkson Avenue between Paris Road and Old 63 North, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements are as follows:

- Speed hump on North William Street south of Amelia Street.
- Speed hump on North William Street north of Richardson Street.
- Speed table at the intersection of North William Street and Windsor Street.
- Bulb-out at the intersection of North William Street and Windsor Street.
- Speed hump on Hinkson Avenue between Melbourne Street and Ripley Street.
- Speed hump on Hinkson Avenue between North William Street and Ann Street.
- Speed hump on Hinkson Avenue between Ann Street and Old 63 North.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the

improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$50,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement project shall be made from Annual Traffic Calming Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement project specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
