Re: Contract Authorization – FY 2022 Consolidated Planning Grant (CPG) (Case # 276-2021)

Executive Summary

Attached is an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute, as contractor for the Columbia Area Transportation Study Organization (CATSO), the FY 2022 contracts for Consolidated Planning Grant (CPG) funds with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission that are derived from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

Discussion

The requested authorization is to facilitate the annual contract renewal of an ongoing grant program. If the authorization is granted, the City would be provided a total of \$630,345 of which \$504,276 is federal CPG funding for FY 2022 transportation planning purposes.

A copy of the CPG agreement is attached for review. Appendix A of the agreement provides funding details per individual work activities.
