CITIZENS POLICE REVIEW BOARD: 2 vacancies with terms to expire November 1, 2028. Members should reflect the cultural and racial diversity of Columbia and have no serious criminal record. A criminal history of all applicants of this Board will be conducted and the City Council will be advised of any convictions for violations of federal, state, or local law. The Board reviews appeals from the police chief's preliminary determination on alleged police misconduct, reviews records of the police department related to complaints of alleged misconduct, and prepares and submits annual reports to the City Council that provide data on citizen complaints related to police misconduct.
