1. 2015 Bond Proposal approved by voters:

2. Electric bond sale and authority:

In 2015, voters approved bonds for replacement and upgrade of existing infrastructure, transmission and substation work, system modernization and system expansion. The majority

of the first bond sale was used to replace and upgrade the electric infrastructure including upgrading substations to account for growth. The dollar amount shown in the project table below is only the bond funds appropriated to the project and does not include any cash funds that may also have been appropriated to the project. Bond funds spent include money encumbered for equipment or a contract. The notes identify project status if there are bond funds remaining to be spent. Bond funds that are not planned to be spent soon, may get reallocated to other projects. There is more than \$29 million available in bond authority that can be used for a transmission line or other capital project. Black & Veatch Corporation is expected to return an updated cost estimate for the transmission project in October 2025.
