

**A RESOLUTION**

authorizing a special event operations agreement with Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. for the Mizzou Watch Party & After Party events; authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street; granting a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet for the area.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a special event operations agreement with Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. for the Mizzou Watch Party & After Party events. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Attachment A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby authorizes Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. to temporarily close a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street, as shown in "Exhibit B" within the special event operations agreement, as follows:

1. November 8, 2025 from 8:00 a.m. through November 9, 2025 to 3:00 a.m.
2. November 15, 2025 from 8:00 a.m. through November 16, 2025 to 3:00 a.m.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby grants Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet, along a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street, as follows:

1. Beginning on November 8, 2025 from 8:00 a.m. through November 9, 2025 to 1:30 a.m.
2. Beginning on November 15, 2025 from 8:00 a.m. through November 16, 2025 to 1:30 a.m.

SECTION 4. As a condition of approval, Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. shall comply with all requirements set forth in the special event operations agreement and by the Special Events Committee, including but not limited to, use of barricades compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic control Devices, and procurement of required liquor licenses and liability insurance.
