Re: Cooperative agreement with Missouri Department of Conservation for financial support

of the Community Conservationist position within the Office of Sustainability

Executive Summary

Staff has created for council approval an ordinance to enter a cooperative agreement with the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) for financial support of the Community Conservationist position. This position was created in FY17 and has been jointly funded by the City of Columbia and MDC since its creation.

Discussion

Attached for your consideration and approval is a Cooperative Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC). This is the first year of a multi-year program where MDC will provide financial support for a Community Conservationist position within the Office of Sustainability. The Community Conservationist coordinates projects educating the community about the social, environmental, and economic benefits to urban conservation.

This agreement may be renewed for two additional one-year terms after June 30, 2020.
