AN ORDINANCE

declaring it is in the public interest to proceed with construction of improvements at A. Perry Philips Park to include the construction of a low-water crossing on the northeast corner of the lake trail and landscaping improvements throughout the park; approving plans and specifications for the improvements; determining that the work shall be done by City employees; providing for payment for the improvement project; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of improvements at A. Perry Philips Park to include the construction of a low-water crossing on the northeast corner of the lake trail and landscaping improvements throughout the park was held by the Parks and Recreation Department on January 10, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a resolution declaring the necessity of constructing the proposed improvements; and

WHEREAS, the notice of a public hearing on the proposed improvements was published in a daily newspaper of general circulation in the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing on construction of the proposed improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that construction of improvements at A. Perry Philips Park to include the construction of a low-water crossing on the northeast corner of the lake trail and landscaping improvements throughout the park is necessary for the welfare and improvement of the City and that it is in the public interest that such improvements be made.

SECTION 2. The plans and specifications for these improvements, as prepared by the Department of Parks and Recreation, are hereby approved.

SECTION 3. As deemed advisable by the City Manager, City employees shall be used to construct the improvements.

SECTION 4. Payment for this improvement shall be made from park sales tax funds, and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
