Re: Amending a Social Services Agreement with Wilkes Blvd. UMC

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to the agreement between the City of Columbia and Wilkes Blvd. United Methodist Church for the purchase of homeless drop-in center services.

Discussion

An agreement between the City of Columbia and the Rainbow House, for the purchase of emergency and transitional shelter services for youth experiencing homelessness, was not renewed due to the closure of the program. The burden of serving these populations has shifted to other providers, including the Wilkes Blvd. United Methodist Church Turning Point program, which is currently contracted by the City of Columbia for homeless drop-in center services.

The amendment will increase the total allowable compensation for program services under the agreement with Wilkes Blvd. United Methodist Church from \$35,000.00 to \$47,638.00, in order to increase program capacity.
