Re: Amending Chapter 13 of the City Code to Add a New Article XIII Establishing Medical Marijuana Business Licensing Regulations

Executive Summary

An ordinance has been prepared to amend Chapter 13 of the City Code to add a new Article XIII to establish medical marijuana business licensing regulations.

Discussion

The proposed amendment to Chapter 13 will add a new Article XIII to provide for the regulation of business license provisions for the cultivation, manufacturing, dispensing, selling, or testing of medical marijuana within the City of Columbia corporate limits as authorized by law. The ordinance is not intended to repeal, abrogate, annul or in any way interfere with existing provisions of other laws or ordinances. All penalty and enforcement provisions not expressly superseded in the establishment of the proposed amendments will remain in full force and effect.
