

Introduced by Treece Council Bill No. R 138-21

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for proposed construction of sanitary sewer rehabilitation project #8 in the Parkade Boulevard, Lynnwood Drive and Albert-Oakland Park areas; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed construction of sanitary sewer rehabilitation project #8 in the Parkade Boulevard, Lynnwood Drive and Albert-Oakland Park areas was held by the City Utilities Department on July 1, 2021, July 8, 2021 and July 15, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on September 7, 2021. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of sanitary sewer rehabilitation project #8 in the Parkade Boulevard, Lynnwood Drive and Albert-Oakland Park areas, which involves the rehabilitation of approximately 17,500 linear feet of sewer line and associated sewer structures, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvements shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of the proposed improvements is \$1,650,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for the proposed improvements shall be made from Sanitary Sewer Utility enterprise revenue funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvements specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
