Executive Summary

The City accepts utility and temporary easements for a variety of reasons. Typically, when it comes to development projects, this is handled by the dedication of right of way on a plat. However, when a platting action is not required, these are provided by a separate document. In addition to the permanent easement, the City acquires temporary easements for construction purposes to allow for use of larger areas only during the time of construction of that project.
