Re: Authorizing Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement with Architects Design Group related to the Molly Bowden Neighborhood Policing Center.

Executive Summary

Authorizing the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 2 to the professional architectural services agreement with Architects Design Group / ADG, Inc. for design services related to the construction of the Molly Bowden Neighborhood Policing Center. The amendment is for a not to exceed amount of \$1,500.00.

Discussion

On March 6, 2017, Council authorized a professional architectural services agreement with Architects Design Group / ADG, Inc. for design services related to the construction of the Molly Bowden Neighborhood Policing Center. The scope of services includes the development of a detailed spatial needs assessment, site analysis, master planning, community outreach program implementation, conceptual design and design services.

Staff is requesting Council to authorize the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 2 to the agreement with Architects Design Group / ADG, Inc. for services related to revising the geotechnical engineering agreement to include design tables for auger cast in place pile (ACIP) recommendations in addition to the recommendations that already exist for this structure. The cost for these additional services is \$1,500.00.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The amendment in the amount of \$1,500.00 brings the total not to exceed design contract amount to \$1,047,865.00 and is being paid from funds allocated from the 2015 Capital Improvement Sales Tax Ballot for this project.

Long-Term Impact: Construction of the facility is estimated to cost \$7,262.500.
