Re: Boone County Public Health Services Agreement

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Boone County for Public Health Services for calendar year 2021 in the amount of \$1,483,834.

Discussion

This ordinance renews the ongoing agreement with Boone County for the provision of public health services. A similar agreement has been in place since 1974 and is advantageous to both parties by minimizing administrative costs and reducing duplication of services. The annual funding level for Boone County is derived from a combination of population and service usage for county residents. The contract amount for calendar year 2022 is \$1,483,834.
