Re: Change to Commission on Cultural Affairs membership requirement

Executive Summary

A request for an amendment to Section 2-232 of the City Code to change the reference for membership qualification for the Commission on Cultural Affairs.

Discussion

The membership composition of the Commission on Cultural Affairs contains a requirement that at least one member be from a business or professional office located within the boundary of the Special Business District (SBD). Although the city still maintains a record of the boundaries of the SBD, for operational purposes the former SBD was replaced by the Downtown Community Improvement District. At the request of City Council, an amendment to Section 2-232 of the City Code has been prepared to change the reference for membership qualification for the Commission on Cultural Affairs from the SBD to the Downtown Community Improvement District.
