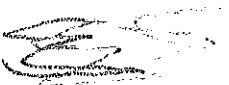

I would ask that the bathroom get a good look as the smell of sewer is sometimes, repeatedly there. Not good for rental or games. There's something going on. The first bathroom in particular has issues. I would emphasize Mahjongg group (plays 5 days a week AM groups and PM groups - 2 at a time so this could be - 6 or 8 up to 24 people playing) need a convenient way to store tables, chairs, table covers, tiles, supplies we provide such as coffee, paper plates, cups, etc and LOCK up separate

From rental storage, we've had many problems with rental people destroying our things. Currently Sara has solved those issues (thank you) but we need to build that separate storage in the new plan.

Acoustics is an issue. It sounds like they are aware but it's really important. If you get more than 2 people it starts to echo around - put 12-16 people in a room it's terrible and

this population is "retired people" so many have hearing issues. The people who rent would also benefit. I think it would help make it a popular rental space. The room needs to be able to be divided, we usually have 2 separate groups playing at one time, both morning and evening. If the space is opened for rental that's great but we need a moveable, sound proof, divider that truly separates the space. It needs to be something "old ladies" can manage. It is very exciting that Parks and Rec is renovating this facility. I started in the first Mahjongg group when it was located behind Stephens Lake. Then we played at the Senior Center while Hillcrest was renovated... Once the Waters House was available we moved to that facility. We had grown in numbers so we quickly filled the space. We have 14 groups that meet every week. This is a very important service that is being provided to our community. When you're retired it means a lot to have a place to go and meet friends, socialize and play a game being researched as helping to keep the mind active and engaged. I teach classes and so it only grows. We've had people come from other states and be impressed saying they had nothing like this. Hillcrest Mahjongg League is a very special group of people (both men and women) who appreciate this facility. Sarah Bowman, Courtney Deters and Jen Meeks all make this special to us. They work very hard and always do their best to accommodate our requests. I might add Hillcrest Mahjongg League frequently plays for various local charities, raising money through donations, silent auctions, etc. Thank you for this investment. It means a LOT to our community.

Taking out the fireplace is a good use of space.

Potential improvements I would suggest are:

Make the storage room into two rooms with a dividing wall and two entrance doors. A pocket door on the mahi side would save place.

The potential glass sliding doors between the two large room could be sliding barn doors. It would visually block the rooms when two different mahi groups are playing at the same time. They would block noise better than glass doors. And less likely for persons to walk into them.

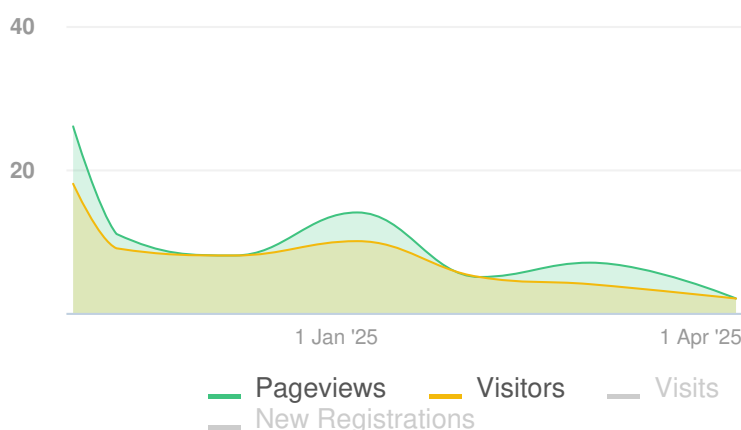

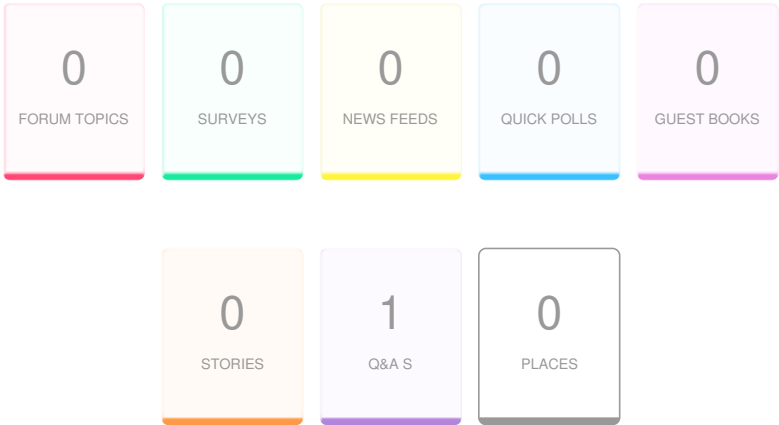

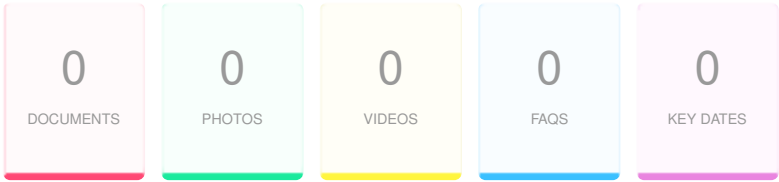
