Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Participation Agreement – State Investment in Local Public Health Services

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for State Investment in Local Public Health Services. The agreement period is June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2024.

## Discussion

This agreement allows the Columbia / Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to receive funding from the State of Missouri for local public health services. In addition to Missouri General Revenue, local public health agencies receive some reimbursement from Medicaid for conducting certain children's health activities. This agreement has been in effect since 2013.
