Re: Resolution Declaring the City Council's Support for Community-Oriented Policing

## Executive Summary

At the request of Council Member Thomas, a draft resolution declaring the City Council's support for Community-Oriented Policing, defining parameters of Community-Oriented Policing, and directing the City Manager to design a citywide Community-Oriented Policing Program for Columbia is being submitted for discussion.

## Discussion

This draft resolution was submitted at the January 16, 2018 and February 5, 2018 City Council meetings. Amendments that were discussed at these meetings have been changed within the resolution and are attached to this memo.

City Council has directed staff to create a plan that modifies current CPD policies, procedures and operations, implement the new program, and provide an evaluation process with goals, objectives and measurable outcomes.

Other considerations mentioned in REP7-18 should be addressed by staff in the transition plan of adopting and implementing Community-Oriented Policing. These other considerations include: aligning with current CALEA accreditation efforts, allowing for ample time of the adoption and acclimation to the new Records Management System, ensuring that the number of officers needed to implement the plan are considered as well as funded, and providing support for Columbia Police Officers throughout the adoption and implementation of this plan.
