AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 2 of the City Code as it relates to duties and responsibilities for the Commission on Cultural Affairs to include the traffic box art program and the cultural activities enhancement program; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2-238. Traffic box art program.

(a) Upon the recommendation of the commission, the city manager is authorized to enter into agreements with artists for art on traffic boxes.

(b) No artist shall receive more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) in any fiscal year under this program and the program is limited to the availability of funds appropriated for the program.

Sec. 2-239. Cultural activities enhancement program.

(a) Upon the recommendation of the commission, the city manager is authorized to enter into agreements with local nonprofit arts organizations for cultural activities.

(b) No program shall receive more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per request. No local nonprofit arts organization shall receive more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) in cultural activities enhancement program funding in any fiscal year.


(c) The cultural activities enhancement program is limited to the availability of funds appropriated for the program.
