A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of the sidewalk and parking lanes within North Village Park along Orr Street, St. James Street, Ash Street and Park Avenue, to facilitate the removal of the existing infrastructure and construction of new sidewalks and parking lane improvements..

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Columbia, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes Reinhardt Construction the temporary closures within North Village Park along Orr Street, St. James Street, Ash Street and Park Avenue, as shown on "Exhibit A" attached hereto, from June 15, 2026 through November 27, 2026 to facilitate the removal of the existing infrastructure and construction of new sidewalks and parking lane improvements as follows:

- Closure of a portion of the sidewalk and parking lanes along the south side of Park Avenue between Orr Street and St. James Street.
- Closure of a portion of the sidewalk and parking lanes along the west side of St. James Street between Park Avenue and Ash Street.
- Closure of a portion of the sidewalk and parking lanes along the north side of Ash Street between St. James Street and Orr Street.
- Closure of a portion of the sidewalk and parking lanes along the east side of Orr Street between Park Avenue and Ash Street.

SECTION 2. Reinhardt Construction shall close the sidewalks and parking lanes only in accordance with the traffic control plans submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying Reinhardt Construction, in writing, of such requirements. Reinhardt Construction shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair or replacement of the sidewalks and parking lanes due to any damage caused by the construction activity. Reinhardt Construction shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. Reinhardt Construction shall proceed with construction activities which require the temporary sidewalk and parking lane closures without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the closure permit by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The temporary closures authorized herein may be terminated by the City Council upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and a determination

such are no longer necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public or is otherwise in the best interest of the public.
