Re: Authorizing FY 2019 CDBG Funding Agreements for Services for Independent Living, Job Point, Food Bank and Columbia Housing Authority

Executive Summary

Council approval of this resolution will authorize the City Manager to execute FY 2019 CDBG funding agreements with Services for Independent Living (SIL), Job Point, Food Bank, and the Columbia Housing Authority. Funding was approved for these projects as part of the FY 2019 Annual Action Plan. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) release of funding for FY 2019 projects is anticipated to be received prior January 20, 2020.

Discussion

The attached agreements authorize FY 2019 CDBG for qualified local organizations approved for funding. FY 2019 funded projects were approved as a part of the FY 2019 Annual Action Plan. Organizations must complete the expenditure of funds as identified in each individual agreement.
