

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: Bus Shelter Construction. This project will include construction of two bus shelters. The first shelter will be located on the north side of Broadway at the Broadway Shopping Center. The second shelter will be located on the north side of Clark Lane at the Lakeview Mall. At each of the locations the bus shelter will include construction of an 8'x5' concrete boarding pad, construction of an 8'x12' concrete pad for the shelter, and installation of the shelter structure. The shelters will be constructed in existing street right-of-way. Staff will utilize a City term and supply contract to complete construction of the concrete pads. The bus shelters will be installed by City staff. Construction is planned for this summer.

Department: Public Works

Estimated cost: \$20,000

Funding source: 1/4 cent CIP Sales Tax

Project meets the following criterion (check one):

- Construction, upgrade or relocation of electric distribution lines less than sixty-nine (69) KV that is estimated to cost less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

No tax bills will be issued for the project.

Project does not require exercise of power of eminent domain.
