

Introduced by Treece Council Bill No. R 1-19

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of a traffic calming project on Rain Forest Parkway; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed construction of a traffic calming project on Rain Forest Parkway was held by the Public Works Department on May 14, 2018 and September 5, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on February 4, 2019. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of a traffic calming project on Rain Forest Parkway necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the construction of two (2) speed tables and one (1) speed hump at the following locations along Rain Forest Parkway:

- Speed table at the intersection of Rain Forest Parkway and Panther Drive.
- Speed table at the intersection of Rain Forest Parkway and Crocodile Drive.
- Speed hump west of Monsoon Lane.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$25,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement project shall be made from Annual Traffic Calming Funds allocated within the Capital Improvement Sales Tax Fund, and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement project specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
