(d) Prohibitions.

...

(2) No person shall be located upon a median in a major corridor intersection and/or on a median that is less than six (6) feet in width unless in the process of legally crossing a roadway. ~~Failure of a person to leave the median after two consecutive opportunities to cross the roadway in a lawful manner is prima facie evidence of a violation of this subsection, unless such person's mobility is restricted to a degree which makes such person unable to safely cross the roadway during two (2) consecutive opportunities. No person shall remain in a median within a major corridor intersection when such median is less than six (6) feet in width and when a pedestrian signal cycle permitting safe crossing is actively displayed, except as provided below. This subsection shall not apply to any person whose disability, mobility limitation, use of assistive device, accompaniment of a child or service animal, or safety considerations make compliance impracticable.~~
