Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment #01 to the program services contract for WIC Local Agency Nutrition Services between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract period remains October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.

Amendment #01 revises the date that the final invoice shall be submitted. There is no funding associated with the amendment.

This contract allows the Department of Public Health and Human Services to provide supplementary nutrition packages and nutrition education to low income pregnant and breastfeeding women, infants, and children through age 5 years.
