A RESOLUTION

authorizing Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. the temporary closure of a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street; granting a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet associated with "Mom's Weekend" celebrations.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby grants Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. to temporarily close a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street, associated with "Mom's Weekend" celebrations, as follows:

- 1. April 10, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through April 11, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.
- 2. April 17, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through April 18, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby grants Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet, along a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street, as follows:

- 1. Beginning on April 10, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through April 11, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.
- 2. Beginning on April 17, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through April 18, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.
