Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Maternal Child Health Services Contract

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Maternal Child Health Services Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$71,288.42 for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

## Discussion

Maternal Child Health funding enables the department to provide community based maternal-child health planning, outreach and education to citizens of Boone County. Prevention and reduction of obesity among children, adolescents and women along with addressing post-partum depression are the focus of MCH activities for the coming fiscal year.
