Re: Local Public Health Disparities Initiative Service Contract

Executive Summary

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to sign the Local Public Health Disparities Initiative Service Contract between the City of Columbia, MO and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the period of March 1, 2022 through May 31, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$466,881; appropriating funds and authorizing an amendment to the City of Columbia Classification and Pay Plan FY2022.

Discussion

COVID-19 has disproportionately affected populations placed at higher risk and who are medically underserved, including racial and ethnic minority groups, and people living in rural communities who are at higher risk of exposure, infection, hospitalization and mortality. The purpose of this contract is to reduce COVID-19-related health disparities; improve and increase testing and contact tracing among populations at higher risk and that are underserved. This funding is also to help PHHS and key partners implement a coordinated and holistic approach that builds on culturally, linguistically and locally tailored strategies and best practices to reduce COVID-19 risk.

PHHS requests approval to amend the City of Columbia Classification and Pay Plan for FY 2022 authorizing two new position classifications: Community Health Worker Supervisor and Community Health Worker. With this funding, the department requests to hire 1.0 FTE Community Health Supervisor and 3.0 FTE Community Health Workers.
