

In 2018, Missouri is on pace to EXCEED 900 traffic fatalities for the third year in a row.




Missouri is ONE of THREE states without a no texting law for all drivers...

Since 2014, cell phone related crashes in Missouri have increased by 35 percent, with nearly 2,600 crashes in 2017.



Distracted driving is not just a younger driver problem. Approximately 70 percent of drivers using cell phones in Missouri traffic crashes were 22 years of age or older.
