- a. Janet Godon - Get About Columbia update
 - i. Status update on the Shepard to Rollins Trail project
 - a) It passed at City Council meeting
 - ii. Update on the MKT bridge replacement project
 - a) Bridge 8 is set in place
 - b) Bridge 7 is getting started
- b. Recreation Trail Program (RTP) 2018 Grant Application scope change
 - i. Changed from the Perche Creek Trail Phase I to the Hinkson Creek Trail: Stephens Lake Park to Clark Lane
 - ii. Change is due to an ongoing abatement project between Columbia City Utilities and the Missouri Department of

Natural Resources

- iii. Staff should receive notification in July regarding funding from the RTP grant.
- iv. Both trail projects are part of the planned 30-mile loop
- c. Mitch Skov
 - i. CATSO Coordinating Committee meeting is tomorrow (Thursday, February 22)
 - ii. At the MODOT Planning Meeting earlier in February, CATSO staff learned that the MoDOT cost share program that was previously suspended has been reinstated
 - iii. 50% cost share between MoDOT and localities
 - iv. Roundabouts and other projects are eligible for this funding
- d. Leah Christian - Update on the Master Plan
 - i. The timeline of the Master Plan is forthcoming and the commission will be asked to review it
 - ii. Suggestions to add or remove of sidewalks should be made and properly vetted

V. ADA Sidewalk Transition Plan – Allison Anderson, Public Works Department

- a. Allison Anderson spoke to the commission about ADA Sidewalk Transition Plan for Columbia this year
 - i. Inventory all sidewalks and right-ways for meeting of ADA standards
 - ii. Improve sidewalks and curb ramps to meet ADA standards
 - iii. Intersection Improvement Projects to fill in sidewalk gaps, asphalt overlays
 - iv. Begin in the city proper first in the summer
 - v. Rank the projects
 - vi. Asked for feedback from the commission
 - vii. Discussion led by Lawrence Simonson included developing required standards for these improvements
 - a) Accountability of Developers where deficiencies exist
 - b) Addition of Audible Pedestrian Signals
 - c) The cost of these improvements and funding availability
 - d) The Ballenger Road (Clark Lane to Mexico-Gravel Road) Improvements
