Re: Approval of property management agreement between the Boone County Historical Society and the City of Columbia.

Executive Summary

This will approve a property management agreement between the City and the Boone County Historical Society who will curate the Historic Maplewood Home.

Discussion

The Historic Maplewood Home is a cultural landmark within Columbia and commemorates the lives of several Columbia founding families – Slater and Margaret Lenoir and Dr. Frank Nifong and wife Lavinia (Lenoir). The Boone County Historical Society will curate the Maplewood home as a museum and tourism destination for the City and receive \$15,000 from the Convention and Visitor's Bureau. The Office of Cultural Affairs will operate as a liaison between the City and the Boone County Historical Society.
