Executive Summary

Authorizing the City Manager to execute a Right of Way Easement with Boone Electric Cooperative to extend underground electric service to FAA Medium Approach Lights at the Columbia Regional Airport.

Discussion

Staff is requesting that Council authorize the City Manager to execute a Right of Way Easement with Boone Electric Cooperative for the purpose of extending the utility to enable Boone Electric to retire overhead primary wire and poles and install underground primary and pad mounted equipment, restricted to an area of 20 feet in width and 10 feet on each side of the centerline of the electric and/or communication systems, off New Salem Road.
