Re: Contract with University Concert Series for arts programming

Executive Summary

This legislation authorizes a contract with The Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the University Concert Series for arts programming in FY2023. Because this is an inter-governmental agreement, the contract needs to be approved by ordinance.

Discussion

This contract is part of the annual allocation of funding for various arts and cultural activities scheduled in FY2023.

The award determination resulted from the Commission on Cultural Affairs annual review process of applications received from local arts organizations. Commissioners reviewed the project proposal during two meetings and offered time for public comment at the July meeting.

The Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the University Concert Series has been awarded \$4,766.00 to present performances during its 2022-2023 season. Funds will be used to offset artist fees.
