Re: Hazardous Moving Violation (HMV) Enforcement Unit Grant FY2022

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing acceptance of the Full Time Hazardous Moving Violation (HMV) Unit Grant in the amount of \$60,746.40 from the Missouri Department of Transportation and authorizing the City Manager to sign the contract.

## Discussion

This grant renewal continues funding one (1) full time HMV officer at 75% of the officer's salary/benefits. This grant position will continue to concentrate on hazardous moving violations in high traffic crash areas. Types of violations include: speeding, driving too fast for conditions and/or following too closely.

This contract period is October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The Full Time HMV Unit Grant will offset 75% of the cost budgeted for one existing officer position in FY22 (\$60,746.40). Both revenue and expense were included in the FY22 budget.

Long-Term Impact: No anticipated cost for years beyond two.
