Re: Authorizing agreement with Missouri State Highway Patrol for MOVECHS access

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the agreements between the City of Columbia and the Missouri State Highway Patrol for access to Missouri Volunteer and Employee Criminal History Service (MOVECHS).

Discussion

Columbia/Boone County Public Health & Human Services (PHHS) Healthy Families America (HFA)Home Visiting Program Contract (OOC24000074) with the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education requires that employees who will have direct interaction with clients and children in the home visiting program undergo criminal background screenings (sections 3.5: B 1; B 3 a; E; and F 1) regarding background checks. In order to comply, the City of Columbia Human Resources will need access to the MOVECHS database through the Missouri State Highway Patrol. Human Resources will complete the required criminal background check will confirm with DESE that PHHS home visiting staff members are able to complete work with the contract. No specific employee information will be shared related to these background checks.
