

A RESOLUTION

authorizing staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Richmond Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #35); directing that a public hearing be held upon completion of the preliminary plans.

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2013, the City Clerk received a petition for the formation of a private common collector elimination (PCCE) project from certain property owners in the vicinity of Richmond Avenue; and

WHEREAS, City's Utilities Department – Sewer/Stormwater Division identified the private common collector sewer main that serves the Richmond Avenue area to be in poor structural condition; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary estimated cost of the proposed Richmond Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #35) is \$255,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Richmond Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #35).

SECTION 2. Upon completion of the preliminary plans for the proposed Richmond Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #35), the City Council further directs that a public hearing be held in respect to this improvement.
