Re: Resolution Approving an Amendment to the Property Management Agreement for the John William "Blind" Boone Home

Executive Summary

This resolution would approve a one-year amendment to the Property Management Agreement with the John William Boone Heritage Foundation for the J.W. "Blind" Boone Home located at 10 N. 4th Street.

Discussion

The City is the owner of the J.W. "Blind" Boone Home and entered in to a property management agreement with the John William Boone Heritage Foundation on June 20, 2016. This agreement allows the foundation to manage and curate the Boone Home and Grounds as a museum space and garden. The city provides \$15,000 in annual funding for management services.

For FY2021, an amendment has been made and approved by both parties, to reduce the funding from \$15,000 to \$7,500 for one year. All other terms and conditions of the agreement remain the same.
