A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of the sidewalk on the south side of Green Meadows Road between Carter Lane and Gray Oak Drive to facilitate the installation of a construction entrance and drive approach for a new commercial development located at 550 E. Green Meadows Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes Forge Development to temporarily close a portion of the sidewalk on the south side of Green Meadows Road between Carter Lane and Gray Oak Drive, as shown on "Exhibit A" attached hereto, from July 16, 2019 to August 30, 2019, to facilitate the installation of a construction entrance and drive approach for a new commercial development located at 550 E. Green Meadows Road.


SECTION 2. Forge Development shall close the sidewalk only in accordance with the traffic control plan submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying Forge Development, in writing, of such requirements. Forge Development shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the sidewalk due to any damage caused by the construction activity. Forge Development shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. Forge Development shall proceed with construction activities which require the temporary sidewalk closure without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the closure permit by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The temporary closure authorized herein may be terminated by the City Council upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and a determination such closure is no longer necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public or is otherwise in the best interest of the public.
