Re: Amendment 02 to the Overdose to Action Program Agreement with Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Overdose to Action Program Amendment 02 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. This contract covers the period of September 1, 2024 through August 31, 2025 and shall not exceed \$56,297.00. This amendment includes an additional \$6,500 to the contract.

Discussion

This contract's purpose is to achieve CDC desired outcomes of decreasing rates of opioid misuse and opioid use disorder, increasing provision of evidence-based treatment for opioid use disorder, decreasing rates of Emergency Department visits due to misuse or opioid use disorder, and decreasing drug overdose death rates, including prescription and illicit opioid overdose death rates. This amendment adds an additional \$6,500 to the contract budget.
